UO-9	"Bill's Own Story" ; Co-founder Bill W. tells of his drinking and recovery. 60 minutes

M-57	Markings on the Journey ; 45 years of A.A. history using material from GSO Archives. 35 minutes
M-58	Circles of Love and Service ; How A.A. works together--from home group to GSO. 16 minutes
VS-1	"Alcoholics Anonymous--American Sign Language" ; 5 tapes-Complete Big Book: includes Preface, Forewords to First, Second and Third Editions; The Doctor's Opinion; All Eleven Chapters; plus Dr. Bob's Nightmare; Appendices: A.A. VS-4	"Alcoholics Anonymous--An Inside View" ; Depicts alcoholics recovering in A.A., going about their daily lives. 28 minutes
VS-8	"Young People and A.A." ; Four young A.A.s describe what it was like drinking, what happened and what it is like now. 28 minutes
VS-10	"Chapter 5 of the Big Book in American Sign Language" ; For the hearing impaired A.A. 48 minutes
VS-11	"It Sure Beats Sitting in a Cell" ; Filmed inside correctional institutions. Story of four young A.A.s in prison for drinking--yet sober today in A.A. 17 minutes
VS-13	"A.A.--Rap With Us" ; Four young A.A.s talk about what it was like drinking; what happened; what it is like now. Lyric sheet available. 17 minutes
VS-16	"Hope--Alcoholics Anonymous" ; Explains the principles of A.A.; what A.A. is and what it isn't; primary purpose; sponsorship; home group; Steps and Traditions; basic recovery tools. 15 minutes
VS-24	"Your AA General Service Office, The Grapevine and the General Service Structure" ; Presents the Fellowship with an overview of the General Service Office and the Grapevine and how they are linked to the general service structure. 22 minutes
VS-25	"Carrying the Message Behind These Walls" ; This video was developed to encourage more A.A. members to participate in carrying the A.A. message into correctional facilities. The film covers singleness of purpose, addresses many of the fears held by outside A.A.s and explains potential obstacles to entering correctional facilities. A.A. members and correctional professionals describe the rewards of this kind of Twelfth Step work. 15 minutes
